E10.3 Toelating

Ten einde tot die driejaar B.Iuris: Beroepsrisikoreg (studiekode 3324) toegelaat te word, moet 'n kandidaat:

- (i) oor 'n geëndoseerde Senior Sertifikaat (tot 2007) beskik en 'n M-telling van minstens 30 punte hê; of
- (ii) oor 'n Nasionale Senior Sertifikaat (vanaf 2008) beskik en 'n TP-telling van minstens 30 punte hê, met 'n minimum prestasiepunt van 50% (prestasievlak 4) in een van die UV se amptelike onderrigtales.

Desnieteenstaande kan 'n kandidaat wat oor 'n geëndoseerde Senior Sertifikaat (tot 2007) of 'n Nasionale Senior Sertifikaat (vanaf 2008) beskik en:

- (iii) 'n M-telling van 24 tot 29 punte of 'n TP-telling van 25 tot 29 punte het, en minstens die eerste studiejaar van 'n verlengde graad-program suksesvol voltooi het; of
- (iv) 'n M-telling van minder as 24 punte of 'n TP-telling van minder as 25 punte het en wat die Universiteit Voorbereidingsprogram (UVP) in geheel suksesvol voltooi het,

op aanbeveling van die dekaan tot die eerste studiejaar van die driejaar B.Iuris: Beroepsrisikoreg (studiekode 3324) toegelaat word.

E10.4 Duur van studie

'n Maksimum van ses semester-modules mag geneem word in die semester waarin die modules wat gedruip of gestaak is, herhaal word. - *Comprehend risk management with specific reference to the evolution of risk management activism factors as well as good corporate governance.*
- *Grasp the concept “duty of care” as well as the meaning and types of legal liability.*
- *Interpret occupational health in the workplace with specific emphasis on the types of health issues as well as the types of hazards that could affect health in the workplace.*
- *Grasp the legal requirements regarding health, safety and the environment, with specific emphasis on the OHSAct, 85 of 1993; COIDA, 130 of 1993; Labour Relations Act, 66 of 1994 and National Environmental Management Act, 19 of 1998.*

SHI132 Incident investigation

The module SHI132 Incident investigation (8 credits) is presented in the Department of Mercantile Law.

- *Comprehend and have insight into incident prevention, with specific emphasis on the consequences of incidents, incident ratio studies, causation model, immediate and root causes of incidents and inadequate systems and control and risk assessment.*
- *Prepare, conduct, record and follow-up actions of an inspection.*
- *Manage incidents in the workplace through gathering evidence, completing investigation reports and noting corrective actions.*
