- 1.1 Only applications from South African citizens will be considered.
- 1.2 The main criteria for the selection of applications is financial need and academic potential. Preference will be granted to prospective students whom are currently using the Cell C SIM card issued to them by Pretune Technologies.
- 1.3 Bursary applications are invited from young people who aim to study full time towards an undergraduate university (academic) degree in Commerce (Economics, Business Economics, Accounting, Investments and Finance), B Com Informatics, BSc Computer Science, BSc Information Technology, BIT-Bachelors of Information Technology, BIS-Bachelor of Information Science, Business Science, Science and Mathematics, Engineering or Commercial LLB and Health Sciences. Please note, though not mentioned, the bursary does cater for those wishing to study at Technikons and FET Colleges.
