Enrollment planning a way to enhance quality

The UFS will in the next few years have to carefully manage its enrollment of students, said Prof. Magda Fourie, Vice-rector Academic Planning, and Mr Willem Malherbe, Registrar Strategic Planning.

Over the past two years rapid growth was experienced at all higher education institutions, including, the UFS. A lack of employment, more learners passing matric every year, availability of financial aid and an increase in living standards

are a few of the reasons why there was an increase of 6,6% in the growth rate at universities in general. At the UFS in particular, the turn-around strategy, better marketing, better programmes and better facilities were responsible for the growth rate above the national average.

Yet the budget for higher education from the National Treasury is a limited one and cannot cope with excessive growth in student numbers. Due to a faster national growth rate than predicted

by government, the Department of Education needs to limit the number of students taken in at universities until 2007. In the future we will have to focus more on quality students and differentiated growth in particular programme areas, said Prof. Fourie.

The incorporation of Qwaqwa and the Bloemfontein campus of Vista also had an impact on the growth of student numbers at the UFS. The Qwaqwa campus must grow for it to be financially viable.

Graduation milestone for the UFS Qwaqwa Campus

On 9 October 2004 the Mandela Hall at the University of the Free State Qwaqwa campus was filled to capacity as the community gathered to celebrate the graduation of 177 students. Among the degrees awarded were one doctorate, eight master's, 31 honours and 46 bachelor's degrees. In addition there were also 91 diplomas awarded.

Qwaqwa campus made history when Dr Motseki Hlatshwayo was the first person from the campus to receive a doctorate in the Natural and Agricultural Sciences. This is a cause for celebration and attests to the resilience of staff and students as well as the commitment and support of the immediate community for the continued offering of relevant post-graduate training on the Qwaqwa campus, said Prof. Peter Mbatlana, Campus Head.

In his welcome speech, Prof. Mbatlana said: "A special day like today is normally only possible due to the de-

education and commitment of many different individuals. It is therefore only fitting that we salute the parents and guardians for all your sacrifices to ensure that your children receive the best education."

The first Deputy President of the SRC, Mr Tello Motloung, also addressed the graduandi. "The year 2004 calls for celebration, as we are not only celebrating ten years of democracy but also your achievements," he said.

Mr Malherbe said that the UFS has made a strong case for further growth at the Qwaqwa campus to the Department of Education.

The positive side of the picture is that we are moving the focus from quantity to quality students and we are optimising students' opportunities to succeed, said Prof. Fourie. This the UFS hopes to accomplish through extended programmes with development modules, tutor systems and other support mechanisms.

Mr Malherbe said effective enrollment planning has to create a balance between admitting new first year students and the through flow and outflow of current students, i.e. enrollment planning has to take account of the number of students who will graduate, who will drop out of the system and who will remain in the system, in order to determine how many new students can thus be admitted to the system. The proportion of undergraduate and postgraduate students and the number of students in the various faculties also play an important role in enrollment planning.

The UFS is utilising the registration process as a mechanism to manage enrollment planning. "We will be more disciplined and keep to deadlines for registrations," said Prof. Fourie. "After 30 November 2004 only applications which are in accordance with our planning parameters will be considered," she said.

Through extended programmes and counseling services the UFS tries to create a learning environment to add quality and prevent a drop in standards. "We want to make higher education accessible to all. Although it makes more demands on human and financial resources, we are committed to face the challenge of creating a balance between equity, redress and quality," said Prof. Fourie.

The enrollment planning process should not have a dramatic impact on staff, said Prof. Fourie. Although the growth phase of the UFS is something of the past, the success of the turn-around strategy has given us a stronger basis on which to build. "We are now ready to enter the consolidation phase where we will focus on quality."

UK grant will help research on SA dunes

The UK based Leverhulme Trust has awarded a research grant of £29 000 (approximately R350 000) for collaborative research into the geomorphic evolution of dune systems, coastal aeolianites and sea level change along South Africa's southern and western coasts, said Prof. Peter Holmes from the Department of Geography at the UFS.

Dr Mark Bateman of the University of Sheffield is the principal grant holder, and Prof. Holmes is the principal South African collaborator. Prof. Holmes introduced Dr Bateman to the Southern Cape during fieldwork in 2001 and the two published their initial findings that revealed dune development associated with sea-level changes over the last 200 000 years.

The bulk of the grant will cover laboratory costs at the University of Sheffield and fieldwork in South Africa. A better understanding of how, and when, South Africa's coastal environments have evolved will provide a context for archaeologists who are reconstructing the origins of modern humans in the Southern Cape region.

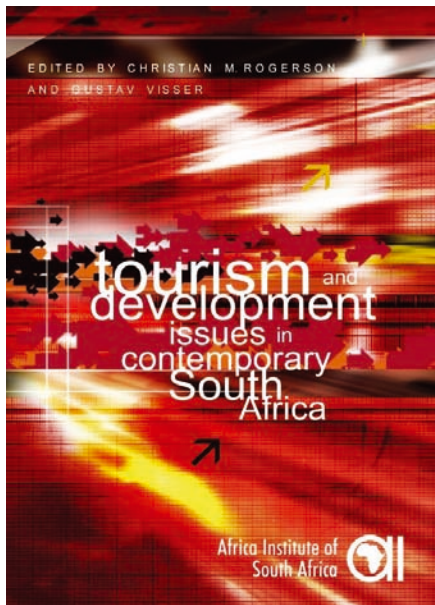
CHESD lecturers in Europe

Three staff members of the section Higher Education Studies and Research in the Centre for Higher Education Studies and Development (CHESD) undertook tours abroad during September 2004.

Prof. Annette Wilkinson, head of the section, visited Austria and South Germany to gain new perspectives on contemporary teaching and learning approaches in higher education, including the use of technology in this regard. She presented a paper at the Multimedia Applications in Education Conference in Graz, Austria, entitled "The developmental role of multimedia applications in a South African University" in which she described the resource-based learning approach in the Career Preparation Programme at the UFS, as well as the role of multimedia in the structured supervision programme for students from developing communities.

Dr Mabokang Mapesela, senior lecturer in the section, took part in a joint poster presentation in Barcelona, Spain, at the European Higher Education Society Conference. The presentation was titled: "Will Institutional mergers lead South African higher education to the 'promised land?'" She also presented a paper on "Deconstructing the Basotho Indigenous Knowledge for possible application in higher education" at the British Educational Research Association (BERA) conference in Manchester.

Also at the BERA conference, Dr Fanus van Tonder, senior lecturer, presented a paper on the developmental work which was undertaken as part of the NRF Performance Management Project. Dr Van Tonder also visited the offices of the Higher Education Funding Council for England (HEFCE) and the Centre for Higher Education Studies (CHES) in London.

Elizabeth Nchapi
Finance is her passion



In 2001 I was asked to assist and was appointed as acting head of the Finance Division. It was really challenging because in a short period of time I had to sit down and learn the job by either consulting those people who left or with the financial advisor that was appointed by the university administrator.

A normal day at the office for Elizabeth starts with a prayer, whereafter she writes in her diary. Now, being ready to face all challenges coming her way, she will check her e-mails, open the cashier's offices and tend to the normal business of the day. After work Elizabeth will leave the office to attend gym and on Tuesdays she likes attending church where she is part of a group who prays and gives advice to the terminally ill.

The community of Qwaqwa is very important to Elizabeth. "People in our community are looking for a better service. Although the Qwaqwa campus is not the same as the other two campuses, because of its unique environment with different needs, we are in the position to deliver a higher standard of service to our community. It is not an easy process but through communication, hard work and an attitude of "we can" we will be able to provide a quality service," she said.

Who is Ms Nchapi, I asked? Without hesitation or fear of revealing too much about herself, or her age, she said: "I was born in Mount Fletcher, a small town in the Eastern Cape, where I matriculated. I am 39 years old and married with three kids named Palesa, Motebang and Molapo. My first name is Moipone, but with four Moipone's on campus everybody calls me Elizabeth."

Holding the fort in the Finance Division at the Qwaqwa campus is a big responsibility, Elizabeth said. "I was always passionate about finance and all my life I worked in the finance department." Elizabeth equipped herself to enhance her skills and knowledge of

Ohio professor talks about peace

US Fulbright professor Dick Weisfelder from the University of Toledo, Ohio, visited the Department of Political Science and held a number of seminars as part of the honours programme in International Relations. His seminars addressed amongst others, South Africa's role in Africa in relation to peacekeeping; the Lesotho intervention in 1998 and subsequent peace building; and the political dynamics of the American presidential election campaign.
