Heart of the campus beats again

An ideal to accommodate senior management in the Main Building came true on 18 July 2005 when the building was again opened for business.

The offices of the Rectorate, certain senior managers and certain Support Services relocated to the Main Building. These includes the offices of the Rector, Vice-Rectors, Chief Directors, Registrar: General (including Language Services and Meeting Administration), Registrar: Strategic Planning, Director: Physical Resources and Special Projects, Director: Diversity, Planning Unit of the UFS and the Strategic Communication Division.

With this move management was brought closer to the academic heart of the university.

The Main Building is the second historical building upgraded and restored in the past year. In 2004 the Rector opened the Centenary Complex where the old Reitz Hall is now the main focus. The Main Building and the Centenary Complex are now being used by the university.

Ms Edma Pelzer, Director: Physical Resources and Special Projects, said it was a challenge to transform a hundred year old building into the head quarters of a modern university. Prof. Bannie Britz was the most suitable architect for the job. He also believed that management belongs in the Main Building and with his stature as architect and his experience in the field he was appointed for the task.

Prof. Britz succeeded in using local and inexpensive building material for the project and kept original material where he could.

"This prominent building today is synonymous with the UFS," said Ms Pelzer.

The Main Building compares well in the international arena according to Prof. Ora Joubert, previously Head of the Department of Architecture at the UFS and now Head of the Department of Architecture at the University of Pretoria. She visited the campus during

the Volksblad Arts Festival and was very impressed with the building.

Ms Pelzer said it is good to receive positive feedback, but it is more important that people working in the building are functioning well. Dr Pieter le Roux from Architecture will soon measure the successful functioning of staff in a building performance evaluation study.

Ms Pelzer also indicated that 38 under cover parking spaces are being built west of the Johannes Brill Building. Twenty-five of these will be for staff in the Main Building.

Papierlose vergaderings trek internasionale aandag

Prof. Sakkie Steyn, Registrateur: Algemeen van die UV, en me. Fientje D'Haeyer, Produkonsultant van Cival in België, het 'n gesamentlike werkwinkel by die 3rd International Conference on Education and Information Systems, Technologies and Applications aangebied. Dié werkwinkel het op 17 Julie 2005 in Orlando, VSA, plaasgevind.

Die titel van die werkwinkel was *E-management of effective decision-making in a higher education environment: a case study*. Prof. Steyn en me. D'Haeyer het geïllustreer hoe 'n sagteware-oplossing wat in België vir toepassing binne munisipaliteite ontwikkel is, by die UV aangepas is vir 'n hoëronderwysomgewing en aangewend word om die algemene probleem van 'n tyd- en koste-ont-effektiewe wyse van voorbereiding vir, verloop en hou van vergaderings hok te slaan.

Die werkwinkel het baie goed verloop en belangstelling in verdere bekendstelling met die papierlose vergaderingstelsel is deur kongresgangers uit verskillende lande uitgespreek.

Prof. Steyn sê die Dagbestuur van die Uitvoerende Bestuur hou sedert 3 Augustus 2004 sy vergaderings ten volle elektronies deur middel van die Parnasus-sakelys- en -notulebestuurstelsel.

"Die elektroniese bestuurstelsel het 'n betekenisvolle bydrae by die UV gemaak in die vorm van 'n dramatiese toename in tyd- en koste-effektiwiteit van vergaderings. Die saamstel van 'n sakelys en dokumentasie van ongeveer 300 bladsye word weekliks na bestuurslede se kantore gedentraliseer en deur die sekretariaat elektronies gemoniteer. Na die sluiting van die sakelys word dit elektronies na lede versprei," sê prof. Steyn.

Die webkoppelvlak vir effektiewer samestelling en publiserings van sake-lyste en notules en die interaksie met inligting in die UV se databasis, sowel as die uitbreiding van die stelsel na groter vergaderings word tans ondersoek.

Tydens die boekbekendstelling was van links prof. Theo du Plessis, Direkteur: Eenheid vir Taalfasilitering, dr. Elbie Truter, navorser in die Eenheid, en prof. Dirk van den Berg, Redakteur van Acta Academica.

Die Eenheid vir Taalfasilitering en –bemagtiging (ETFB) het 'n nuwe publikasie, *Die ontplooiing van die taalbeleid in die onderwys (1652 – 1961) met spesiale verwysing na die uniale periode*, die lig laat sien. Hierdie publikasie ondersoek die historiese konteks van die taalbeleid in die onderwys, 'n tema wat in die jongste tyd weer in die kollig staan.

Die geskiedkundige perspektief wat die publikasie bied, vul 'n leemte wat

rondom die dokumentering van taalbeleidsontwikkeling vir die onderwys in Suid-Afrika bestaan. Uit hierdie publikasie kan ons leer om nie die foute van die verlede te herhaal as dit by taalbeleid in die onderwys kom nie. Die publikasie is veral relevant vir die huidige debat in Suid-Afrika oor moedertaalonderwys en dubbelmedium-onderwysprojekte.

Die uitgawe is beskikbaar by die Publikasiekantoor van die UV-Sasolbiblioteek.

The designation of the head of the Qwaqwa Campus, Prof. Peter Mbatlana has changed to Campus Principal. This and other changes to the top structure on the campus were approved by the UFS's Executive Committee.

They also recommended that all the line managers on the Main Campus should liaise and consult with the Campus Principal on matters significantly impacting the operations and management of the Qwaqwa Campus. Decisions

taken by the line managers on the Main Campus that affect the Qwaqwa Campus must demonstrate that a proper consultation process with the Campus Principal and/or other relevant officials on the Qwaqwa Campus has been followed, and vice versa. It is important that appropriate administrative assistance be given to the Campus Principal in the day-to-day operational management of the campus.

The Qwaqwa Campus Co-ordinating Management Committee has

recommended that Dr Eugene Malete and Mr Teboho Manchu should assist the Campus Principal in the day-to-day operational management of the academic and support services functions respectively on a temporary basis for the next six months. Both will serve as members of the Campus Principal's Advisory Team. Dr Malete is the Programme Head for Humanities and Mr Manchu is Deputy Director: Student Affairs.

Die TRW word reeds sedert Januarie 1976 gepubliseer as 'n geakkrediteerde nasionale tydskrif wat oorspronklike navorsingsartikels in die regsgeleerdheid in Afrikaans en Engels publiseer.

Die Eeufeesuitgawe van die TRW wat saamgeval het met die Eeufeesvieringe van die UV, is saamgestel uit bydraes van die personeel van die Fakulteit Regsgeleerdheid en die Skool vir Rekeningkunde.

Ondermeer is die intrede van appèlregter Joos Hefer, *Billikheid in die Kontraktereg*, wat hy gelewer het as die eerste ereprofessor in Privaatreg aan die UV, in die tydskrif gepubliseer. Dit bevat ook 'n omvattende uiteensetting van die geskiedenis van die Fakulteit, opgestel

Labirint laat baie wonder

Wat is dit dié? Net regs agter die Hoofgebou op die hoofkampus van die UV – dit is nou as jy voor die gebou staan – is daar 'n “iets” of 'n “ding” soos so baie wat daar verbystap daarna verwys en daaroor wonder.

In die verbygaan hoor jy 'n gedempte gefluister agter-die-hand: “is dit nie dalk satanies van aard nie”, of “dit is Oosters en mens sukkel nie met daardie gelowe nie”.

Prof. Bannie Britz, argitek wat verantwoordelik was vir die restourasie van die Hoofgebou slaan alle praatjies die nek in en vertel dat die labirint – ja, dit is wat dit genoem word – 'n Westerse gebruik is. Eeue gelede het Christene dit in van die mooi Gotiese kerke in Europa aangebring om te mediteer.

“Die labirint is deel van die gebruik van die Hoofgebou. Mense is nou baie meer kantoorgebonde as vroeër jare. Die labirint is 'n geleentheid vir personeel van die Hoofgebou om weer met hulself kontak te maak. Personeel kan uitkom in die buitelug en mediteer of van hul stres ontslae te raak,” sê prof. Britz.

Die heining gaan toegerank word. Die wat wil mediteer sal dit in privaatheid kan doen waar mense van buite hul nie kan sien nie.

'n Labirint het draaie soos 'n doolhof, maar het geen doodlooppaadjie nie. Die pad waarmee jy ingaan is die een waarmee jy uitkom. Daar is geen regte manier om 'n labirint te gebruik nie, maar daar is 'n paar riglyne wat kan help om die regte denkproses aan die gang te kry. Voordat jy ingaan, raak stil en gesentreerd. Gaan dan in terwyl jy op die fisiese stapproses fokus op pad na die middelpunt. Die middelpunt word gebruik vir meditasie en stresontlading.

Met die raaisel nou opgeklaar, is daar nog steeds die wat bly wonder. Wie gaan die eerste tree gee? Of soos iemand gesê het, wie gaan die baan open?

“Do unto others as you would like them to do unto you.” This is Ms Mamokete Ratsoane’s motto in life. She is the Head of the Human Resources Department at the Qwaqwa Campus.

Ms Ratsoane deals with labour relations challenges such as disciplinary and grievances procedures on an ongoing basis. She expressed her concern about highly qualified staff leaving the campus. “From January 2005 seven out of the 266 staff members left. People leave the Qwaqwa Campus for greener pastures at other universities or the private sector where they believe they will receive better salaries.” She added that the incorporation with the UFS and the alignment of services to those of the Main Campus were not the main reasons why staff had already left the campus.

Recruits are interviewed but they turn down the offers. She feels the reason for that is two-fold: “People apply for positions here, without knowing where the

campus is situated. Many then turn down job offers when they see where the campus is,” she said.

Secondly she believes that appointing staff temporarily causes them to leave. Ms Ratsoane said: “Temporary staff will get permanent jobs elsewhere and leave. This is a threat to the campus as it gives a perception that the campus will not be there in a year or two.”

To equip and better herself for her tasks in the Human Resources Department she completed her B.Comm. degree and enrolled for a B.Comm. Honours at UNISA. She is not only successful in her studies, but made significant progress with her career at the Qwaqwa Campus. Since her appointment in 1998 as personnel officer, she has worked her way up to Assistant Director: Human Resources. She was also appointed as the acting head of the Human Resources

Department. “I enjoy management’s support in this position. This appointment was the highlight of my career at the university. I would definitely like to be the permanent head of the Human Resources Department on the Qwaqwa Campus,” she says.

Ms Ratsoane believes that women do not have a large slice of the cake when it comes to senior positions. However, she does believe that this will soon be addressed by the university’s Employment Equity policy.

After a day filled with challenges Ms Ratsoane likes to recharge by watching television soap operas. She also enjoys attending church and reading the Bible, as well as good motivational books.

But for the 39-year old single mother her two sons Tshitso (15) and Tumisang (7) are the love of her life. “They are my reason for living,” she said.

Prof. Grobbelaar open kongres in China

Prof. Johan Grobbelaar van die Departement Plantwetenskappe aan die Universiteit van die Vrystaat het die openingslesing gelewer by die tiende driejaarlikse kongres van die *International Society for Applied Phycology* wat van 24-28 Julie 2005 in Kunming, China, onder die beskerming van die Chinese Akademie vir Wetenskap en die Nasionale Stigting vir Natuurwetenskappe plaasgevind het. Sy onderwerp was *Photosynthetic characteristics of Spirulina platensis grown in commercial scale open outdoor photobioreactors*.

Afgevaardigdes van 38 lande het die kongres bygewoon. Hoogtepunte van die kongres was die belangrike rol van alge om veral die kooldioksiedprobleem en klimaatsveranderinge van die wêreld op te los en die geweldig toename wêreldwyd in probleme met toksiese alge en gesondheid.

Prof. Grobbelaar doen reeds meer as 30 jaar navorsing oor algiotegnologie en is betrokke by die grootste komersiële spirulina-produksie-aanleg by Musina in Limpopo.

"We flew out of South Africa on 13 June 2005 and came back on 28 June. This was a historic experience for me. Our choir was the only one from Africa to be invited to the concert," she said during an interview with Tumi Tabane from Strategic Communications at the UFS.

The choir, which falls under PACOFS and is led by Ms Virginia Seane, had the opportunity to perform alongside choirs from Miami, Moscow and Vienna.

Ms Mogopodi, who sings alto, said: "Several concerts were planned for our choir, including two in Prague's famous

St. Nicholas Church, as well as concerts in Koblenz, Salzburg, Berchtesgarden, Hallstadt and Vienna.

"People in the countries we visited were very kind to us. The only challenges were the language and the extremely hot weather in Germany.

"Our trip was sponsored by the Free State Department of Arts and Culture. The assistance of the Chief Director: Community Services, Rev. Kiepie Jaftha, and the Rector of the UFS, Prof. Frederick Fourie, made it possible for me to go on this trip.

"I never thought I would be granted an opportunity to go abroad through my music. Young people must explore their talents. After my high school years, I took singing as an extramural activity. I never went to school to study music, but this talent took me to places I never thought I would get the opportunity to visit in this lifetime," said Ms Mogopodi.

Soos wat die begrippe *samelewingsdiens* en *samelewingsdiensleer* mettertyd op universiteitsvlak ontwikkel is, het die Fakulteit Regsgeleerdheid daarmee tred gehou, en sit so vandag ’n trotse tradisie voort,” sê mnr. Neels Swanepoel, Direkteur van die Regshulpklinik.

Die Regskliniek van die fakulteit is die vlagskip van gemeenskapsdiensleer vir dié fakulteit. Baie arm lede van die publiek ontvang gratis regsdienste en

finalejaar-regstudente verrig gemeenskapsdiens ter verwerwing van akademiese krediete.

Elke student moet ’n minimum van 120 uur per jaar op die wyse by die kliniek deurbring. In 2005 was daar 78 studente wat hul praktiese regsopleiding aan die UV-regskliniek uitgevoer het.

Die kliniek identifiseer weerlose groepe binne die gemeenskap en streef om die nodige toegang tot die reg aan hul te voorsien.

Die samewerking en insette van die Fakulteit Regsgeleerdheid is grotendeels verantwoordelik vir die sukses van die

Regskliniek. Dit is vir die fakulteit ’n top-prioriteit dat die grootste moontlike inspraak ontvang word vanaf die georganiseerde regsprofessie oor wat van die nuut afgestudeerde regstudent verwag word.

By die Hof vir Klein Eise in Bloemfontein het die fakulteit die voortou geneem, tot die mate dat vyf van die agt Bloemfonteinse kommissarisse van die Hof vir Klein Eise lede van die fakulteit is.

Die UV-regskliniek is geakkrediteer by die Regsgemeenskap van Suid-Afrika by wyse van sy akkreditasie by die Regsvereniging van die Vrystaat.
