The University of the Free State (UFS) is situated in Bloemfontein, a city in the Free State province in the heart of South Africa and birthplace of two big political movements almost a century ago that shaped the history of South Africa, namely the African National Congress and the National Party.

The UFS was established in 1904 as the Grey University College with a handful of students. Today we pride ourselves on more than 30 000 students.

We have three campuses, namely the Main Campus in Bloemfontein, the Qwaqwa Campus growing in popularity in the picturesque Eastern Free State and the South Campus in Bloemfontein, mainly used for occasional and career-preparation programmes and bridging programmes.



A strong contingent of students is from countries in Africa and other countries around the globe.

On our Main Campus a vast variety of programmes are offered in seven faculties for undergraduate and postgraduate students. More and more students from outside South Africa are enrolled, some in programmes in which the UFS is a leader in Africa.



- Our success rate is more than 70% and every effort is made not only to make facilities and circumstances on campuses conducive for study, but also to prepare prospective students for study at our university.




Total number of students: 29629, of which more than 60% are black/coloured/Indian.


Gender distribution of graduates.

International students




About 2 200 international students are from mainly African countries. We also have students from Europe, the Americas and Asian countries.
