#### SHORT OVERVIEW OF RESEARCH AND SCIENTIFIC BACKGROUND/EXPERIENCE/TRAINING

Mariëtte van Straaten acquired in 2008 her B.Soc.Sc. (Social Work) degree with distinction from the University of the Free State. From February 2011 until December 2014, she worked at the National Institute for Crime Prevention and the Reintegration of Offenders (NICRO) Bloemfontein. Ms van Straaten acquired her Master's degree in Forensic Social Work with distinction at the University of the Free State in 2012. Ms van Straaten's mini-dissertation focused on the expectations of court personnel for forensic court reports with regard to social work. Since February 2011, 276 clients have been referred for a Non-custodial assessment, of which 258 clients were sentenced as recommended. Ms van Straaten started her part-time private practice in 2012 and went full-time into private practice in January 2015. She was the Adhoc Afrikaans Intermediary for the Sexual Offences Courts in Bloemfontein from October 2015 until December 2017. Ms van Straaten is an ad-hoc lecturer at DiMTEC and the Placement liaison officer of the Department of Social Work, University of the Free State. She is registered at the South African Council for Social Service Professions, the Association for Social Workers in Private Practice and the Board of Health Care Funders of Southern Africa.
