

Areas of interests

- **Community Interpreting (CI)** - a form of interpreting which takes place in settings where issues of everyday life are communicated or daily life services are provided, e.g. basic services such as health care, security, municipal services, judicial services, etc.
- **Community Translation (CT)** - a form of translation which takes place within a particular local community and is aimed at enhancing communication.
- **Terminology development** – the focus of terminology development is invention of new terminologies for development in various sectors of our everyday lives. Of interest is the development of academic terminology in the previously marginalized languages in South Africa.
- **Translanguaging** - a concept where multilingual speakers make use of various communication practices to carry a message across to the receiver.
- **Human Development theory** - a process that enlarges people's choices. The theory is a contrast to *dependency* and *modernisation* theories which preceded it.
