

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### UFS HONOURS BURSARIES 2017

The University of the Free State has allocated funding for 130 Honours Degree Bursaries for 2017. Bursaries are available for both full-time and part-time study.

**Closing date:** 19 December 2016

#### Who can apply?

- All South African and international students wishing to pursue their honours degree
- Before applying for a UFS bursary students need to have gone through the formal application process and must have been admitted to an academic programme

Please see section above for *Registration Fee Waiver for First Time Honours Degree Students*.

#### Non-eligible students

- Students who are registered for postgraduate diplomas, certificates, LLB, or are in their fourth year of their Bachelor's degree, are NOT eligible for UFS honours bursaries

#### What is covered?

- Successful applicants will receive up to R30 000 (once off payment) for their honours degree study which will be deducted from the tuition fees on their student account

#### What is NOT covered?

- Bursary holders are still responsible for residence prepayments (payable in February), accommodation and living costs
- Unsuccessful bursary applicants are responsible for their tuition fees, residence prepayments (payable in February), accommodation and living costs

**Closing date:** 19 December 2016

**Notification:** All successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mid-February 2017.

**Payment:** Successful candidates will receive the credited amount of up to R30 000 (once-off payment for full-time students) on their student account by March 2017. Part-time students receive R15 000 per year for two years.

#### Wat word NIE gedek nie?

- Beurshouers is steeds verantwoordelik vir koshuis-voorstelbetalings (betaalbaar in Februarie), verblyf- en lewenskoste
- Onsuksesvolle beursaansoekers is verantwoordelik vir hulle klagelde, koshuis-voorstelbetalings (betaalbaar in Februarie), verblyf- en lewenskoste

**Kennisgewing:** Alle suksesvolle en onsuksesvolle aansoekers sal teen middel-Februarie 2017 in kennis gestel word.
