

## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: UFS HONOURS BURSARIES 2017

The University of the Free State has allocated funding for 130 Honours Degree bursaries for 2017.

### Who can apply?

- All South African and international students from any higher education institution are eligible
- Funding is available for both full-time and part-time study
- The applicant must have a minimum average of 65% in the third year-module in which they want to pursue the Honours degree
- Only students who have completed their undergraduate qualification in the minimum time can apply

### Value of bursary:

Full-time students: R30 000 for one year

Part-time students: R15 000 per year for two years

**Closing date:** 19 December 2016

Please see section regarding *Registration Fee Waiver for First-Time Honours Degree Students*.

**Notification:** All successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mid-February 2017.

Please note: Students are strongly recommended to apply for additional funding from institutions such as the National Research Foundation (NRF).

### Terms and conditions:

Successful candidates will receive their grant allocations by March 2017. The bursary amount will be credited to their student account.

All students (including non-South Africans) are advised to apply for both the NRF and UFS bursary (please note the application form applies to both the UFS and NRF bursaries). The selection committee will first allocate NRF bursaries. Candidates who were unsuccessful with the NRF bursary will then be considered for the UFS bursary.
