

NATURAL IMMUNITY objection explained



No unvaccinated visitors are allowed on our campuses, visitors cannot apply for exemption.

Please refer to our <u>website</u> and policy for detailed information.



Staff members and registered students who are not vaccinated, but who have recently tested positive for SARS (COVID-19), can apply for a deferral/exemption based on their natural immunity.

Natural immunity exemption is only **valid three months**. You **can apply** for a **three-month extension** with a sufficiently **positive antibody test**.

How to access campus while waiting for exemption:

- Apply for exemption.
- Email <u>VanHeerdenLC@ufs.ac.za</u> or <u>FonjanaY@ufs.ac.za</u> for assistance with uploading test results.
- Upload weekly COVID-19 PCR or rapid antigen negative test on Fridays before 10am to gain access on the following Monday.
 QR codes are available within 24 hours after upload.
- Tests are valid from the date of the test for eight (8) days, including the date of the test.
- Complete a daily COVID-19 screening questionnaire.
- Present you campus access card, QR code of the COVID-19 screen questionnaire, and complete a temperature check.

How to access campus after receiving exemption:

- Upload your exemption letter issued by the Vaccination Exemption Committee to the UFS system.
- Upload weekly COVID-19 PCR or rapid antigen negative test on Fridays before 10am to gain access on the following Monday.
 QR codes are available within 24 hours after upload.
- Present you campus access card, and permanent QR code.
- Random screening at the UFS gate may apply.
