Prior to Professor Kondlo's appointment at the University of the Free State, he held a variety of positions: Policy and Research Executive at the National Prosecuting Authority; Special Policy Advisor to the Department of Land Affairs and Agriculture in Pretoria; Chief Executive Officer of the South African Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SACCI); Visiting Research Associate at the Centre for Policy Studies in Johannesburg; and Executive Director of the Democracy and Governance Programme of the Human Sciences Research Council.

He is also a Visiting Professor at the Wits School of Public and Development Management and the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University Business School. In addition, he has a longstanding research-related association with the University of Basel's History Department and Centre for African Studies, in Switzerland.

His academic research focuses on governance and public policy, and his recent publications include two books: "Africa in Focus – Governance in the 21st Century" and "The Zuma Administration – Critical Challenges".

Hy is ook 'n Besoekende Professor aan die Wits Skool vir Openbare en Ontwikkelingsbestuur en die Nelson Mandela Metropolitaanse Universiteit se Bestuurskool. Daarbenewens het hy 'n lank gevestigde navorsingsverwante werksverhouding met die Universiteit van Basel se Departement Geskiedenis en Sentrum vir Afrikastudie in Switserland.

Sy akademiese navorsing fokus op regeerkunde en openbare beleid, en onder sy onlangse publikasies is twee boeke: "Africa in Focus – Governance in the 21st Century" en "The Zuma Administration – Critical Challenges".
