

The University of the Free State congratulates the schools in its UFS Schools Partnership Project for massive improvements in the Grade 12 examinations in 2011, surpassing the national average, and contributing to the fact that the province had the largest increase in pass rates from 2010 to 2011. The Schools we honour are:

Bainsvlei Combined School	from 14.3% (2009) to 100%
Ntemoseng Senior Secondary School	from 36.84% (2009) to 93.87%
Hodisa Technical School	from 35.98% (2009) to 85.36%
Moroka Senior Secondary	from 76.92% (2010) to 84.8%
Goronyane Secondary School	from 51.96% (2009) to 83%
Kagisho Comprehensive School	from 43.91% (2009) to 76.1%
Ikanyegeng Comprehensive School	from 60% (2010) to 76%
Lekhulong Senior Secondary	from 56.85% (2009) to 74%

These schools are part of a unique intervention project intended to turn around the learner performance, especially in the last three grades of high school leading to senior certificate examination.
